NEW ANTI-FROST BALL BIB COCK VALVE

In addition to the anti-frost ball valve, we have just brought out a new anti-frost bib cock valve in time for winter.

When water freezes, it expands which causes damage to standard ball valves, but with the patented ball design, the anti-frost valve allows the expanding water to escape from behind the ball and pass safely downstream of the valve — preventing the valve from breaking.

HP High Performance Tempering Valve

The new Caleffi High Performance (HP) Tempering Valve will be available towards the end of July. These high performance tempering valves have a special, highly sensitive thermostatic element which quickly reacts to changes in water temperature, as is commonly experienced on instantaneous hot water systems.

The green capped HP tempering valve is suitable for installation on instantaneous hot water systems and other systems where water supply temperature fluctuates dramatically.

The Caleffi 5213HP Tempering Valve are extremely compact and feature anti-scald thermal shut-off on both hot and cold water failure. The valve includes built-in non return valves, strainers and union ends.

Sizes are available in 15mm and 20mm.
