NEW Product:

Caleffi Double Check Valve

All Valve Industries will soon be releasing a new addition to the Caleffi range, the Double Check Valve (DCV) code #3049.

The Caleffi DCV utilises the body components of the Caleffi Reduced Pressure Zone (RPZ) backflow preventer and this enabled them to keep development costs to a minimum. Our DCV is rated as suitable for use in medium hazard risk areas to prevent contaminated water from flowing back into the mains supply. At this stage, there is one size valve available and that is 20mm, the most popular size of DCV's.

Recent regulations require houses with rainwater tanks to install a double check valve. The DCV should be installed between the mains supply and the first outlet, as close to the meter as possible at the property boundary, creating a safety zone which prevents the water within the property from coming into contact with the mains supply.

The Caleffi DCV comes complete with approved isolation valves and a strainer. As stated previously, this valve is presently only available in 20mm. All Valve can supply other sized DCV's on request.
